*We are blessed with generous members who keep our church vital. Below are just a few of the stories and activities where we have had a meaningful impact on those in need... near and far:*

**Samaritan Counseling Center** TPCS has been the most generous church donor to the faith based SCC for almost 20 years. Our support has helped many of the center's clients - our neighbors - overcome debilitating disorders and turn their lives around.

**After-School Programs** We sponsor a safe place and constructive environment - led by Scott and a team of volunteers - for elementary, middle and high school students. The numbers are still growing! We have committed funds for the new Community Youth Worker. The metric that there are nearly 400 kids on free or reduced lunch in the QVSD highlights the need of this outreach.

**Adult and Youth Mission Trips** Scott and Tracey led mission trips outside of our valley to NC and LA this year which had big impacts on those served and those in service. If you were at TPCS the week after the mission teams returned and heard the testimonies of those young and young-in-heart who participated, it would be hard not to be impressed and feel blessed to be associated with their efforts. Scott and Tracey are leading new mission teams to the Gulf Coast and Malawi this fall.

**Refugee Resettlement** Since January a dedicated team of TPCS members has given more than generously of time, talent and treasure to relocate, welcome and support two Bhutanese families who had been living in refugee camps in Nepal. This mission continues for those involved with daily needs from transportation and job sponsorship to just being a timely friend to those without the established networks of friends and family that we sometimes take for granted.
